

APPRENTICESHIP OPPORTUNITY

Eligibility: TVET College graduates meeting the minimum academic requirements in the form of:-

- **N3 certificate with four subjects and a relevant trade theory in Bricklaying**
- **Relevant Engineering NC(V) Certificate with seven subjects at NQF Level 4 in Masonry.**

Applicants must be willing and available to undergo a structured training, deployment and rotation to any approved workplace leading towards a qualification as artisans. Applicants must be South African citizens. This programme does not guarantee post-apprenticeship employment to graduates owing to participation in the programme.
